# Radio Buttons, Checkboxes & Selects





# Radio Buttons

Radio buttons are used when a user is allowed to select only one option from a list of options.

Radio buttons are created using the <input> tag with the type attribute set to "radio".

Each radio button in a group should have the same name attribute and a unique value attribute.

## Example:

```
1 <input type="radio" name="gender" value="male"> Male
2 <input type="radio" name="gender" value="female"> Female
```



## Checkboxes

Checkboxes are used when a user is allowed to select multiple options from a list of options.

Checkboxes are created using the <input> tag with the type attribute set to "checkbox".

Each checkbox should have a unique name attribute and a value attribute.

# Selects

Select menus are used when a user is allowed to select one option from a dropdown list of options.

Select menus are created using the <select> tag, which contains <option> tags for each option in the dropdown list.

The selected option is sent to the server when the form is submitted.
